

Descendants of Peter Raub

R Peter Raub arrived in Philadelphia on board the Loyal Judith on 25 September 1732. He arrived with three other Raub members: Phillip Roup, Micheal Roup and Hans Jurg Roup (John George Raub). They all took the Oath of Alligence on the same date.

Peter and Hans Jurge relocated to Williams Township, Northampton County, PA.

Peter died intestate on 13 June 1740 according to one record on his estate; though this date has been disputed with other researchers.

He married Susanna. They lived in Williams Township, Northampton County, Pennsylvania. Susanna attended the Old Williams Church in Williams Township. She is listed as a communicant in the April 15, 1751, May 17, 1752 and April 22, 1753 communion records for that church.

R1 Michael Raub was born 17 April 1733 was baptized in 1733 according to the Old Williams Congregation Church Records. His baptism was sponsored by Martin Maulin and wife Sabina. He was a farmer. He died intestate about 1816.

A list of Michael's children who owed him money is contained in his estate records, File No 3315, Volume p 1816. The Administrators for his estate are: Christopher Raub, eldest Son, Forks; Henry A. Raup, son-in-law, William; Samuel Niegh, Forks and John Raup, Williams, Yeoman.

He married Maria Elisabeth Mayer on 11 June 1754 in the Evangelical Lutheran Augustus Church of Trappe, New Providence, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania. She was a daughter of Jacob Meyer and Elizabeth Kepler.
